A FAMILY GAME BOARD GAME.

In Penguin Paths players compete as penguins searching for fish in Antarctica!

By drafting tiles and building paths players score points by catching fish in an innovative scoring mancala system.

Penguin Paths is a short exciting game that is enjoyed by children and adults.



Players draft a tile and place it onto their board



Players use dice try to move on paths they created. There is a bonus if they can't move



Land on scoring spaces to catch fish. Fish then swim away changing scoring for other spaces.

Key Features

- Light family weight game play tested and enjoyed by children, but adults described as having more depth than first appears
- Twist on Roll and Move with players strategically building their own paths
- No 'do nothing' turns. Always something to do if dice don't fall well.
- Exciting 'Mancala' scoring system that creates fun tactical decisions.

Components list

- 4 x player mats
- 1 x Antarctica mat
- 4 x Player aids
- 75 x punchboard hexagonal tiles (15 x 5 unique tiles)
- 4 x player tokens penguins
- Scoring tokens (estimate 50 in 1/5/10)
- 12 x fish scoring pieces.
- 2 x custom 6 sided dice.

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
